

Questions and Answers FY 2019 Solicitation (Part 4)

Q30: Where can I find the catchment areas on the website?

A30: Catchment areas are found in Section B. Catchment areas can also be found on our website under "Request for Proposal information".

Q31: Is all of San Bernardino part of a single catchment area or is the city of San Bernardino and Running Springs?

A31: There are several catchment areas in San Bernardino County, which are identified on our website. These include:

- San Bernardino County East -Cities of San Bernardino, Grand Terrace, Colton
- San Bernardino County West -Cities of Rancho Cucamonga, Ontario, Upland
- San Bernardino County - High Desert (Cities of Apple Valley, Victorville, Yucca Valley, Lucerne Valley, Barstow)
- San Bernardino County - High Desert (Cities of Apple Valley, Victorville, Yucca Valley, Lucerne Valley, Joshua Tree, Barstow)

Q32: If we have sites in different catchment areas, will we have to have another application with a different BPA solicitation number?

A32: Yes, each BPA is specific to each catchment area. Multiple BPAs can be applied for from the same provider.

Q33: What if I have facilities in 2 catchment areas that are providing same services?

A33: You would need to submit proposals for both catchment areas using only the site(s) that are included in each catchment area as defined in Section B.

Q34: What if we are not providing all of the services listed in Section B, would we put down NC or NA (not applicable)?

A34: If you are unable to provide all services listed in Section B, your proposal will not be found technically acceptable.

Q35: Can I submit corrections to my previously submitted proposal?

A35: The closing date has passed (July 26, 2018) for all RFPs except RPF #'s 973-19-13 and 973- 19-18 (which were re-solicited and close August 20 at 12:00 noon . These can be found on our website.
